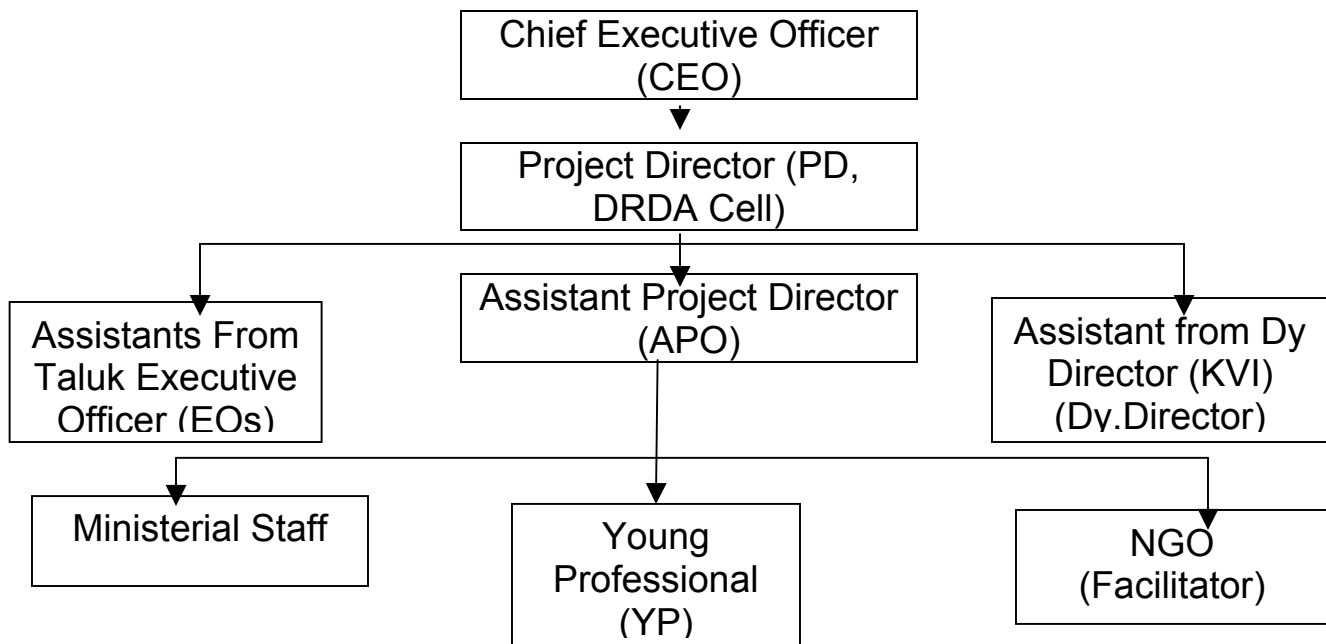


Project Director, DRDA Cell

The District Rural Development Agency (DRDA) is visualized as a specialized and professional agency capably of managing the anti poverty programmes of the MORD on the one hand and to effectively relate these to the overall effort of poverty eradication in the district. The DRDA is a supporting and a facilitating cell and works under the chief executive officer of the Zilla Panchayat, The DRDAs will maintain their separate identity and is expected to co-ordinate effectively with the Panchayath Raj Institutions (PRIs)

Organisational Structure

Administrative Costs:-

All the administrative Costs of the DRDA were funded by centrally sponsored scheme of DRDA Administration in the ratio of 75:25 basis between centre and state, aims at strengthening and professionalizing the DRDAs.

Schemes / functions of DRDA

The following schemes / Programmes are implemented in DRDA Section:-

Swarna Jayanthi Gram swarojgar Yojana (SGSY)

1. The objective of the SwarnaJayanthi Gram Swarojgar Yojana(SGSY) is to bring the assisted poor families (Swarojgaries) above the poverty line by ensuring appreciable sustained level of income over a period of time. The scheme was launched from April 1999. This is a holiastic Programme Covering all aspects of Self Employment such as organization of the poor into self help Groups (SHGs), training, Credit, Technology, Infrastructure and marketing. SGSY will be funded by the centre and the state in the ratio of 75:25. The emphasis under this programme will be on the Group approach.

- 7. To assist in Organising exhibitions, melas, Fairs, Tabulos and to Co-ordinate the SGSY beneficiaries to participate in the SARAS Melas, Exhibitions Etc.,**
- 8. To Co-Ordinate the Various Training Institutes working / assisted under the RDPR.**
- 9. To assist in organizing Self employment and wage employment Training to the Rural Unemployed Youths.**
- 10.To monitor special Projects approved under SGSY**

11. Any other works entrusted by the CEO.
